What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Nikko AM Multi-Strategy Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Description of this fund

The Fund aims to outperform the Bloomberg NZ Bond Bank Bill Index plus 2.5% p.a. over a rolling three year period after fees and expenses, before taxes. The Fund provides investors with access to a multi-manager, multi-strategy investment programme designed to generate capital appreciation over the long term through a portfolio having a diversified risk profile with low to medium volatility. 1


Example of how this applies to an investor

Chris had \$150,000 in the fund at the start of the year⁵ and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Chris incurred a loss after fund charges were deducted of \$2,220 (that is - 1.48% of his initial \$150,000). Chris paid no other charges. This gives Chris a total loss after tax of \$4,185 for the year.

Notes

Expenses: The fund expenses during the period were 0.21%.

MSFII charges: The fixed proportion of the MSFII fee is 1.0% of the net asset value of MSFII. This is the management fee charged by JPMAAM, payable monthly in arrears, which is reflected in the unit price of MSFII. The variable proportion of this fee is estimated by us and includes performance fees and expenses of MSFII and management fees and performance fees of underlying fund managers of MSFII. This estimate is calculated in accordance with the method set out in summary in the Nikko AM NZ Other Material Information document (on the offer register at www.business.govt.nz/disclose).

¹ Currency hedging is material to the fund. Hedging is undertaken by the underlying fund manager. In the underlying, unrelated fund, investments in local currencies are first hedged to USD; then the aggregate value of the entire portfolio in USD is hedged to NZD.

² Because the fund is less than five years old, the risk indicator uses returns data partly from returns of the fund, and partly (for the period September 2011 to 22 April 2014) from the underlying Nikko AM Wholesale Multi-Strategy Fund.
