What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Nikko AM NZ Corporate Bond Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Description of this fund

The Fund aims to outperform the Bloomberg NZBond Government 0+ Year Index by 1.50% p.a. over a rolling three year period before fees, expenses and taxes. The Fund provides investors with regular income by constructing an actively managed investment portfolio of New Zealand bonds, deposits and cash while protecting the capital value of investors' funds.

What are the risks of investing? Risk indicator for Nikko AM NZ Corporate Bond Fund:

Example of how this applies to an investor


Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Hayley had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year² and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Hayley received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$615 (that is 6.15% of her initial \$10,000). Hayley paid no other charges. This gives Hayley a total return after tax of \$441 for the year.
