What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Nikko AM ARK Disruptive Innovation Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. 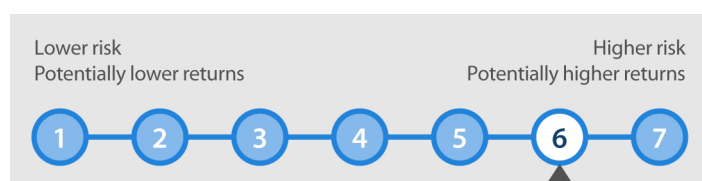
Description of this fund

The fund aims to outperform the benchmark of an absolute return of 10% per annum over a rolling five-year period before fees, expenses and taxes. The fund provides access to a global share portfolio that offers thematic exposure to disruptive innovation across a number of sectors, and geographies.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for Nikko AM ARK Disruptive Innovation Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (very low) to 7 (extremely high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Nikko AM ARK Disruptive Innovation Fund are charged fund charges. Based on the PDS, dated 17 March 2020, these were expected to be (inclusive of GST where applicable):

Example of how this applies to an investor

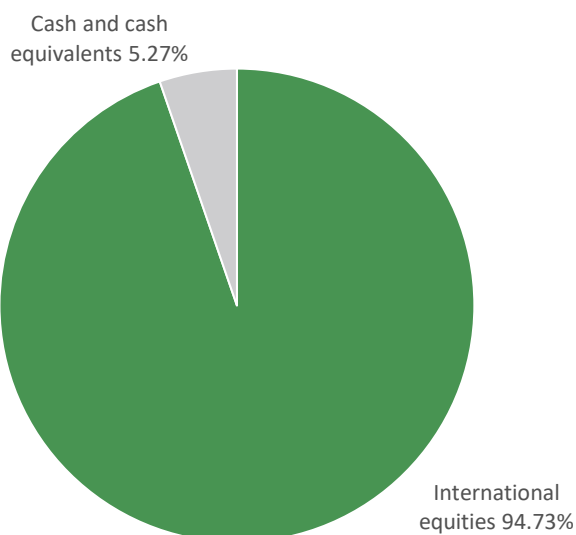
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Noah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Noah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$13281 (that is 132.81% of his initial \$10,000). Noah paid no other charges. This gives Noah a total return after tax of \$13057 for the year.²

Notes

¹ Because the fund is less than five years old, the risk indicator uses returns data partly from returns of the fund, and partly (for the period January 2016 to August 2019) from the NASDAQ-100 (in NZD). As a result of this, the risk indicator may provide a less reliable indicator of the potential future volatility of the fund.

² For the purpose of this example, the start of the year is 1 January 2020.
