Fund Update



What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the GoalsGetter Nikko AM NZ Corporate Bond Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Nikko AM NZ prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The Fund aims to outperform Bloomberg NZBond Credit 0+ Year Index by 0.70% p.a. over a rolling three year period before fees, expenses and taxes. The NZ Corporate Bond Fund aims to generate income by constructing an actively managed investment portfolio of New Zealand bonds, deposits and cash whilst preserving the capital value.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the GoalsGetter Nikko AM NZ Corporate Bond Fund

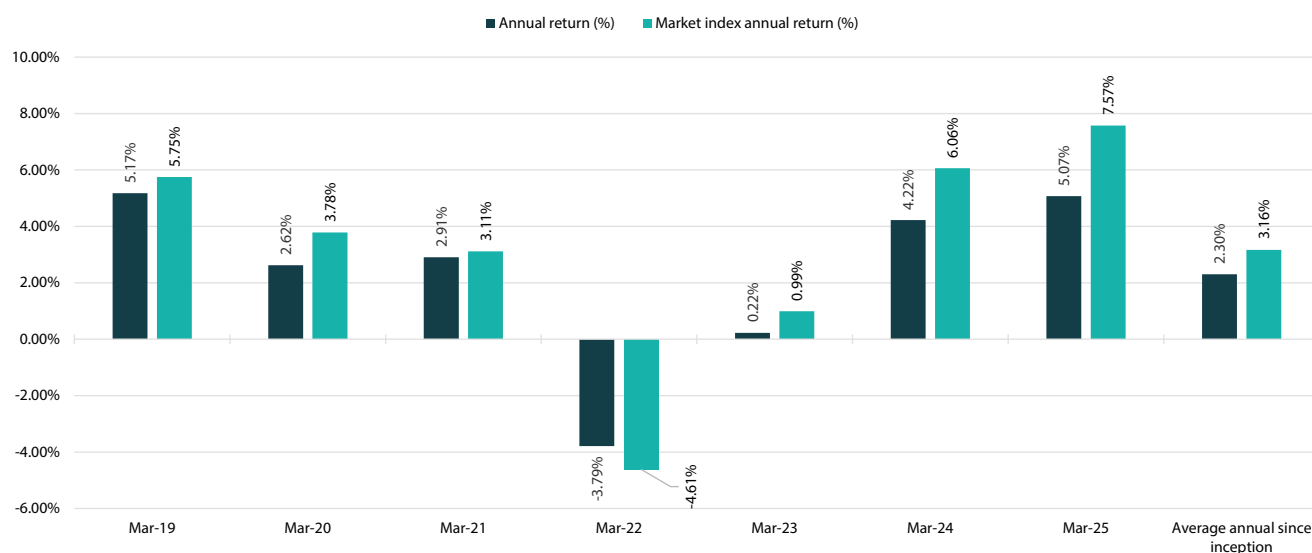
How has the fund performed?

Example of how this applies to an investor

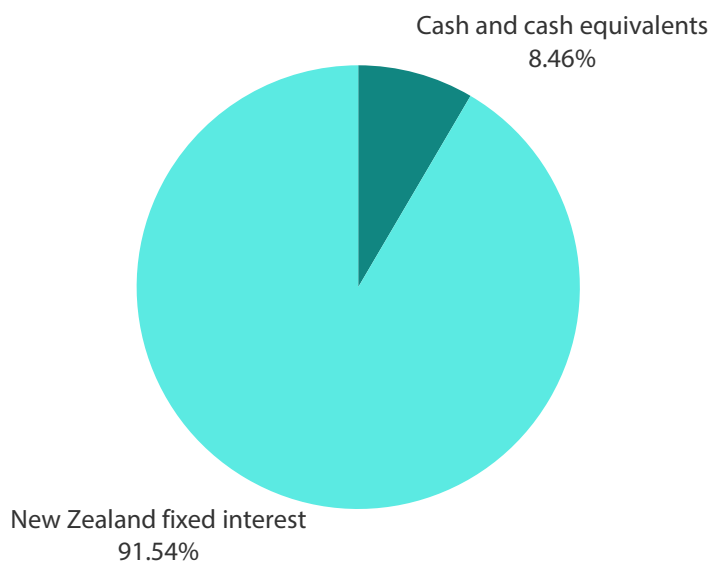
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Simon had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Simon received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$712 (that is 7.12% of his initial \$10,000). Simon also paid \$30 in other charges. This gives Simon a total return after tax of \$477 for the year.²
